The Single Subject Credential in Japanese requires a minimum of 30 upper-division units. Students will complete 24 upper-division units selected from the following as Basic Core and 6 Electives. (*If the student is placed in JAPN 302/312 or above as a result of the placement test, s/he may be required to substitute other courses listed below or appropriate courses in other related areas selected with the assistance of an advisor

Core Requirements:

Twenty-four (27) upper division units selected from the following five areas:

_____ Language: **JAPN 301, 302, 311, and 312**

_____ Linguistics: **JAPN 461**

_____ Literature: **JAPN 471 plus 421 or 370**

_____ Culture: **JAPN 451**

Electives:

Six units selected from at least two different areas in consultation with a program advisor based on the student's background, interest, and teaching plans:

_____ Language: **JAPN 421, 422**

_____ Linguistics: **JAPN 462, 481**

_____ Literature: **JAPN 370**

_____ Culture: **JAPN 350, 492**

_____ Variable Subjects: **JAPN 490; 497**

Native speakers of Japanese who have completed more than 7 years of mandatory education in Japan may not enroll in any language courses unless otherwise advised by a program advisor. Those students may substitute other courses listed above or appropriate courses in other related areas selected with the assistance of an advisor.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all courses accepted for the Japanese program. The exit requirement is "Advanced" level Japanese language proficiency.
