

Asian BCLAD Consortium Student Teaching Application

To student teach as an Asian BCLAD Consortium candidate, you must complete the following:

1. Attend the student teaching application meetings offered by the Field Program Office to pick up application materials. (This must be done one semester before you plan to start student teaching.)
2. Mark your language of emphasis (Chinese, Khmer, Vietnamese or Korean) next to “BCLAD Coordinator Signature” on the application form.
3. Obtain signature from the Asian BCLAD Coordinator and sign up on the student teacher applicant sheet.
4. Make sure to check off ALL boxes in STEP ONE & STEP TWO on the “Application Instructions” sheet
5. Submit your completed application packet to
 - a) Credential Center (ED-42) and THEN to
 - b) Field Programs Office (ED1-50-51)
6. Attend all student teaching orientations offered by Field Programs Office.
